



## COLLEGE AND FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Jackson State Community College and the Jackson State Community College Foundation invite you to apply for scholarship opportunities that recognize students for their academic, extracurricular, and fine art achievements. Scholarships to Jackson State are provided through college and state funding as well as private donations to the JSCC Foundation. All scholarship applicants will be considered for the academic service scholarship and any Foundation scholarship of which they meet the minimum criteria. Meeting the minimum criteria does not guarantee a scholarship will be awarded. **Please mark in the appropriate box(es) on this form if you wish to be considered for the Access and Diversity or Innovation Ensemble Scholarships.**

### General Criteria for Scholarship Consideration:

- Application must be complete and submitted by **March 15** unless otherwise indicated
- Applicant must be a high school graduate or hold a G.E.D. or HiSET
- Applicant must demonstrate a potential for academic success or leadership
- Applicant must be accepted for admission to JSCC prior to consideration for scholarships
- Applicant must enroll as a regular student in a degree or certificate program
- Applicant must maintain enrollment as a full-time student unless otherwise indicated
- Applicants who are first-time freshmen are required to submit a copy of their high school transcript (seventh semester) and a written recommendation from a high school administrator
- Applicants who are transfer students must submit a copy of their prior academic work
- Applicant must reside within the West Tennessee service area
- Applicant must meet additional requirements if specified
- Applicant must maintain satisfactory academic progress
- Applicant must demonstrate need for financial assistance for some scholarships
- **Incomplete applications will not be reviewed**

### Instructions for Completing the Application Process:

1. Apply for admission to Jackson State Community College.
2. Complete and sign this scholarship application.
3. If you hold a G.E.D. or HiSET, submit a copy of your official score.
4. If you are a graduating high school senior, a high school transcript (seventh semester) must accompany this application. Attach to your application a written recommendation letter from a high school administrator and have them complete the "High School Information" on page 3.
5. If you are a transfer student, submit a recent copy of your prior academic work.
6. Complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Make sure to add the school code 004937 for Jackson State.

### Foundation Scholarships

✓ **All applicants will be considered for all Foundation scholarships for which they meet the requirements.** Scholarships provided by the Jackson State Community College Foundation are intended to increase access to Jackson State. They are made possible by contributions from businesses, civic organizations, clubs, and individuals in the college service area. Each scholarship has individual criteria for the awards that are established by the scholarship donor. A detailed listing of the Foundation scholarships and their criteria can be found on the last page of this document.

### Academic Service Scholarship

✓ **All scholarship applicants will be considered for the Academic Service Scholarship.**

The Academic Service scholarship is provided for students who demonstrate academic ability and an interest in being part of campus by working in one of our departments. Recipients will complete 75 hours of college service per semester for full-time attendance. Recipients are required to enroll for at least six or more hours each semester. The scholarship award amount, and the service hour requirement, will be prorated down for part-time enrollment. To receive full benefits, recipients must enroll in at least 12 hours. The scholarship covers tuition, technology, activity, access, and international education fees for up to 12 credit hours. No other fees will be covered. New students must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average and an ACT composite of 19 or higher, or a GED score of 510 or higher, or a HiSet score of 45 or higher. Continuing and transfer students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and at least 12 credit hours earned.

### Access and Diversity Scholarship

**Please check this box in order to be considered for the Access and Diversity Scholarship.**

Jackson State offers Access and Diversity Scholarships to full-time and part-time students (at least six hours) in support of underrepresented populations in higher education. These scholarships are offered as a way to reduce financial barriers for those students and increase equity in college majors. Award amounts per semester vary from \$200 to \$2,000 for full-time students and \$200 to \$1,400 for part-time students, dependent on available funds. This scholarship has a priority deadline of March 15, but is available throughout the academic year if funds are available. Scholarships are targeted at four specific populations. **Please check one or more of the areas for which you should be considered:**

- students who are adults ages 25 and over
- students who are African-American males
- students in a major that is non-traditional for their gender (ex. males in nursing or females in engineering)
- students who are non-native English speakers (attach TOEFL scores, a school transcript in your native language, a school transcript showing ESL courses taken, or other documentation of being a non-native English speaker).

Scholarships do not cover out-of-state tuition or additional charges for TN eCampus classes. All renewals are subject to funding.

### Innovation Ensemble Scholarship

**Please check this box in order to be considered for the Innovation Ensemble Scholarship.**

The Innovation scholarship is available to students who are accepted into JSCC's Innovation choir on campus. Eligible students will complete the required application and audition before the ensemble director. Upon acceptance into Innovation, students can receive up to a full semester's tuition as well as a book stipend of up to \$300. Students must keep a minimum 2.0 GPA and actively participate within the group as required by the Innovation director to maintain eligibility for scholarship renewal.

- \$250 to full tuition and fees (up to 12 hours)
- Demonstrate need for financial assistance

- \$250 to full tuition and fees (up to 12 hours)
- Reside within Hardin County
- Demonstrate need for financial assistance

- \$250 to full tuition and fees (up to 12 hours)
- Reside within Hardin County
- Demonstrate need for financial assistance

## Mary Jo Boehms Endowed Scholarship

- Up to \$400 each semester
- Must be a full-time student
- May be enrolled in any major
- Maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher

## Haywood County Scholarship

- \$500 per semester only
- Haywood County high school graduate
- ACT score of 19 or above
- Enroll in an Industrial Technology Program
- Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Renewable for four consecutive semesters

## Lexington/Henderson Co. Project Success

All Project Success Scholarships:

- \$250 per semester
- Resident of Henderson Co. three most recent years
- Renewal requires 2.0 GPA each semester

### Current High School Graduate:

- Enroll full-time college level or developmental courses
- Maintain continuous full-time enrollment

- Unemployed due to plant closing or layoff

- Be of a minority race, with first preference to African Americans
- Reside within Henderson County, with first preference to residents of Lexington; applicants from Madison County may be considered if there are no applicants from Henderson County
- Enroll in an Industrial Technology Program
- Renewal for second semester requires 2.0 GPA

## Dr. F.E. Wright Merit Scholarship

- Covers in state tuition and fees (up to 12 hours)
- Current high school seniors only
- ACT score of 20 or above
- High school activities and leadership abilities are considered
- Maintain GPA of 2.75 each semester
- Renewable for four consecutive semesters

- Demonstrate need for financial assistance
